



Within the framework of the 6th European Landscape Biennial which will take place on the 30th September to 2nd October 2010 in Barcelona

The 6th Rosa Barba European Landscape Prize has been announced

The deadline for presenting project documentation is February 26th, 2010

Barcelona, on the twenty third of November 2009, The 6th Rosa Barba European Landscape Prize has been announced within the framework of the 6th European Landscape Biennial, which will take place on the 30th September 1st and 2nd of October 2010 in Barcelona with the slogan "liquid landscapes". The main goal of this Rosa Barba European Landscape Prize convocation is to focus on the most outstanding landscape projects created in Europe in the last past years. —from 2005 to 2009—. The European Landscape Biennial has expressed its desire to intently study and discuss landscape interventions, as much from the perspective of landscape architecture as from other disciplines that are linked to its study and evolution.

The Biennial is organized by the Association of Architects of Catalonia (COAC), the Polytechnic University of Catalonia (Master's Program in Landscape Architecture and the Association of Friends of the UPC), and the Department of Territorial Policy and Public Works (Architecture and Landscape Division) of the Autonomous Government of Catalonia. And in this edition Agbar is also collaborating.

The selection of projects will give grounds for an Exhibition, which will serve as the basis for selecting the VI Rosa Barba Landscape Prize and the posterior publication of an international catalogue. There will be a sole award, which has an economic value of 15,000 €. All the projects must be delivered at the biennial offices before the 26th of February of 2010.
